This Saturday, October 18, we will be having our annual awards ceremony and pot luck.

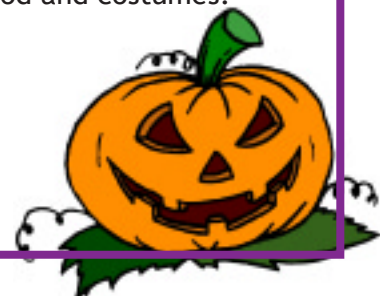
This is the first time that the Cadettes have planned the entire ceremony and will also carry it out. They have made some great plans.

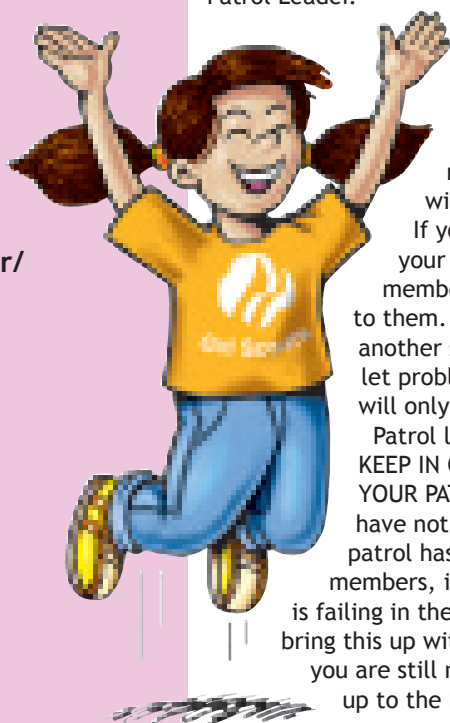

T-SHIRTS

On November 4, we plan to tie-dye shirts AGAIN! This is for two reasons: many of the girls have never done this and we have run out of shirts for the Brownies.

I will be placing the order for the shirts on October 20th. You must pay for them on the 18th or I will not be able to order them. **WE WILL NOT BE MAKING EXTRAS!**

The t-shirts are \$5 each, sweatshirts are \$7 each and I will be ordering bandanas

for \$3 each. If you don't need troop shirts but still want to tie dye your own, you can order blank white shirts for \$4 each and \$6 each. Or if you want to make extras along with your troop shirts you can order more.

EVERY GIRL MUST HAVE A TROOP SHIRT! This is our uniform (along with the vest).

Well girls, your getting much older now and that means you will be having more responsibility placed upon you.

Since our elections there have been two incidences where we had a communication breakdown and girls were not notified of events.

This is YOUR TROOP, not mine. Leaders, you are responsible for the troop running smoothly (you are all listed on the left).

You are also required to set the example. You are responsible for wearing your FULL UNIFORM, BRINGING YOUR BOOKS, etc. If you don't do this, how can you expect the other girls to?

Troop members, I have listed all the leaders phone numbers and positions on the left. If you have a problem, you need to call them and discuss it. The chain of command goes first to your Patrol Leader, then the Patrol Advisor, then the Asst. Senior Patrol Leader, then the Senior Patrol Leader.

If you do not get the results you expect, then you can call Juliana.

Please try to resolve all conflicts within the troop.

If you are unhappy with your patrol leader, troop member, etc, try to talk to them. Or, go directly to another senior officer. Don't let problems fester or they will only get worse.

Patrol leaders, YOU MUST KEEP IN CONTACT WITH YOUR PATROL. Some of you have not done this and your patrol has missed out. Patrol members, if your Patrol Leader is failing in their communication, bring this up with them and then if you are still not satisfied, bring it up to the PLC (Patrol Leaders

Council).

Patrols, you are encouraged to meet on your own at a time other than the regular meetings to discuss badges that you are responsible for organizing. Or meet and work on badges on your own. I think you will find this to be easier and more fun for certain badges.

Remember, as a patrol, you are REQUIRED to organize the badge you voted on last meeting. It is your responsibility to determine how and which items you will work on to earn the badge.

Remember, communication is the key to a successful troop. This is something you really need to work on, but I know you can do it!

Badges and Try-Its

LIL' RASCALS PATROL, you are in charge of organizing the Water Sports Badge. This means you will decide which requirements the troop will work on. You must have this planned by November 4.

On November 15 we plan to begin work on this and the Brownies will begin work on the Water Everywhere Try-It.

I plan to meet at the NMMI Pool, but you need to set this up as well as any other activities we need to complete there. I would be glad to sit down with you and help you do this.

Brownies and Cadettes - every girl MUST have their books by November 4. You also MUST BRING THEM TO EVERY MEETING unless we tell you otherwise. Cadettes, I will be nice this awards ceremony and give you your badges, but will no longer get them for you if I do not see a signed book.
